Tournament Details

Check-in

- Check-in begins at 9:00 a.m. near the horseshoe pits.
- Athlete packets and shirts will be there for pick up.

Format

- Each athlete will throw 30 shoes alongside another athlete.
- Due to the small numbers in horseshoes, some may not be in direct competition.
- Below are the registered athletes.
- Upon arrival, you'll be paired with another athlete.
- A ringer will count as 3 points.
- A shoe within 6 inches of the stake will count as 1 point.
- The number of ringers will act as a tie breaker.
- Men 50-69 throw from 40 feet
- Men 70+ throw from 30 feet
- Women 50-74 throw from 30 feet

Medal Ceremony

- The medal ceremony will take place shortly after the completion of all throwing.
- Must be present to receive medals. They will not be mailed.
